

# **Calgary Farmyard-Calgary Corn Maze**



Visit Calgary's original corn maze where their huge, mind-bending corn maze will keep you guessing. Correct pathways even for the most directionally-challenged visitors – adults and children alike – will require about one hour to travel through the maze and an hour and a half if you try and get to all the stations. Try out other cool attractions too: mini golf, barnyard petting zoo, zip lines, ropes course, mini mazes (age 8 and under), pedal karts, jumping pillows and all farm playground activities. Lots of amazing activities to do!



When: **Friday, October 4th** (registration deadline is Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>)

Time: 1:00 – 3:00 p.m.; meet at the entrance

Who: Grades 1-12 (under 2 years is free) (Children under 12 must be supervised)

What to Bring: water, snacks, bug spray, suntan lotion, fall coat, hat and appropriate footwear.

Cost: \$11 per adult chaperones and students

Because there are so many activities to do, we will meet at the main entrance. There is lots of parking on site as well.

There are events at the corn maze that are not included in the gate ticket price, such things as paintball, feeding the animals in the Petting Zoon and gemstones. So, bring some extra change if you'd like to enjoy these.



**Note:** There is a concession on site, which has a great collection of food, snacks and beverages. Also, feel free to bring your own food and they have a covered area to eat too.

**Location: Calgary Farmyard: 284022 Township Road 224 Rockyview, AB T1X OJ6**

We are located on the southeast tip of Calgary, 1.4 km east of the city limits

#### Driving Directions

1. Take Stoney Train SE (Highway 201) to Highway 22X East
2. Take the Highway 22X East exit. This exit is located at the very southeast corner of Stoney Trail (where Stoney Trail changes from running east/west to north/south)
3. Drive on Highway 22X East for 3.2 Kilometres (approximately 2 minutes) to Range Road 285 (watch for a blue Calgary Farmyard highway sign prior to this intersection as well as a RV storage place with a big white fence)
4. Turn right (south) onto Range Road 285
5. Drive 1.4 Kilometres and take your first left (east) on Township Road 224
6. Drive 1.6 Kilometres. The Calgary Farmyard is on the left
